

Response	I am wondering if people would be willing to share their schedules for how they run class periods etc for blended learning or digital learning models.
1	We are an on cite ALC and follow the school bell schedule but do a 2 hr block of time for our ALC. Most course work is done digitally
2	Our blended learning schedules are for out of school time programs, like Evening HS and S-Term, where we do only credit recovery in core content areas. I don't think there's room here for a description. If you'd like more information or a copy of our summer schedule, call me at 651-744-8013.
3	We run an 8 period school day starting at 8:20, ending at 3:20 with a 30 minute lunch period. Students are scheduled with a credit recovery digital curriculum class within the regular school day. The core content teacher(also the teacher of record): social studies, science, English, are also scheduled into the computer lab to work with students during that main credit recovery class period. In addition we also offer credit recovery outside of the school day 2x a week from 3:20 - 5:00 pm. If you would like a copy of our schedule, please email me.
4	We run a 5 period day at both of our ALC sites. 4 of the classes are 85 mins. We have 1 advisory period of 30-40 mins based on the two different sites. As part of our blended learning models we offer staff time during the regular schedule day for students to drop in for work on I.S. or digital learning time. We also offer time after school for this as well. We also have students come in before school starts to work on I.S. digital learning. Basically, we have a core 5 period day of regular classes. But, for those kids doing I.S./Online classes we offer chances to come in all throughout the day.
