Already this year, our organization has begun working with legislators regarding some of the key issues and concerns that are spelled out in the attached Legislative Platform. We encourage you to review this document with your students, however, the goal of the MAAP STARS Legislative Day is for the students to visit their legislators and “tell their stories”. By students meeting with their legislators, they will help promote their schools/programs and give the students a better understanding of the legislative process. You will find a sample letter or E-mail that could be used for contacting your legislators. Everyone will make their own appointments with your legislators. We will meet as a **whole group at 9 a.m. in the State Office Building, Room 500 South.**

Since you serve students from various locations, you will want to make finding out which representatives to contact into a lesson for your students. Have the students look online "How to locate your Minnesota Legislators". The address is: [www.leg.state.mn.us](http://www.leg.state.mn.us). At this site, your students will find all sorts of information about their Legislative and Congressional Members. There is a link "About the Legislature" with a lead to "Who Represents Me?" Students can type in their home address and it sends them directly to the names of the people they'll want to contact to set up appointments for February 27, 2019. From this site, you can also get the representatives' phone number, email or direct mailing addresses.
